Strategic Plan | 2019 – 2024**

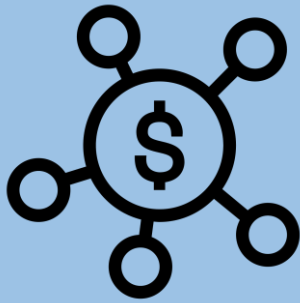


The Board of Directors of the Valley Housing Fund consists of elected officials and community leaders who are committed to creating affordable, accessible, and energy efficient housing in the Valley.

Three Phase Approach: We accomplish our mission through three phases of support to the local governments, agencies and those looking to develop quality, energy efficient homes in the Gunnison Valley. Through grants, loans, and an inventory of developable land, the Valley Housing Fund seeks to provide funding and locations for our community and our diverse citizens to live.

Our Goal | Participate in the development of 400 affordable, accessible, and energy efficient housing units by 2024.

Land

Establish an aggressive land-banking program that creates an inventory of land that will eventually be developed into affordable and attainable housing to serve our growing communities. It may potentially be integrated with free market housing to make a project viable.

At time of development of these sites, the Fund will work with an agency or partner with a private sector developer in order to ensure the long term affordability of housing in the development.
